Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order (which was made on the 23rd January 2024) or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the appropriate legislation, or on the grounds that any requirement of such legislation, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the 23rd January 2024, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

On the 28th February 2023, Flintshire County Council made an Experimental Order to introduce a One Way system on the School Access Road into on Crosstree Lane, Hawarden, from its Northern side junction with Crosstree Lane to its Southern side junction with Crosstree Lane.

This will allow for additional parking within the inner part of the $\mathbf{p} \, \mathbf{q} \, \nabla \, \mathbf{H} \, \mathbf{F} \, \mathbf{W} \, \mathbf{L} \, \mathbf{R} \, \mathbf{Q} \, \mathbf{R} \, \mathbf{Q} \, \mathbf{C} \, \mathbf{M} \, \mathbf{S} \, \mathbf{K} \, \mathbf{H} \, \mathbf{G} \, \mathbf{F} \, \mathbf{K} \, \mathbf{F}$ road, which will alleviate the parking and congestion on Crosstree Lane at school pickup and drop off times.

The County Council continues its responsibility to consider the provision of convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the measures are aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised to all road users.

As the Experimental One Way Order was a success Flintshire County Council is now making this Order to introduce a One Way system on the School Access Road into on Crosstree Lane, Hawarden, permanent.
