Notice of Making

THE FLINTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (NEW STREET CAR PARK, MOLD) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) (EXCEPT COACHES) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that on the 18th October 2022, Flintshire County Council made an Experimental Order in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, under Sections 9, 10 and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be :-

1) To prohibit any vehicle, Except Coaches, from entering the designated Coach Parking facility within the New Street Car Park, Mold.

The Experimental Order will come into operation on the 28th October 2022 for a period of 18 months. A copy of the Order, plans showing the roads affected by the Order, together with during

normal opening hours at Flintshire Connects, Mold Library, Earl Road Mold CH7 1AP or they may be viewed on our website at www.Flintshire.gov.uk > Resident > Roads, Streets and Travel > Traffic Regulation Orders or you can request a copy of the documents by emailing Streetscene@flintshire.gov.uk or by calling 01352701234.

The Council will be considering, in due course, whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of 6 months from the coming into force of the Order, or if the Order is subsequently modified or varied, from the coming into operation of that modification or the variation (whichever is the latest), any person may object to the making of the Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation.

Objections to the Order, together with the grounds on which they are made, should be sent in writing to the undersigned within six months of the date on which this Order shall have come into force, or the date on which any variation or modification or the latest variation or modification shall have come into force and quoting the reference SS/TRO/JB/EO//2022

If it appears essential to the Council that it is necessary in the interests of the expeditious, convenient or safe movement of traffic or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any length of road affected by the Order runs, then the nominated Officer of the Council below, may modify or suspend the Order or any provisions thereof.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Experimental Order (which was made on the 18th October 2022) or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the appropriate legislation, or on the grounds that any requirement of such legislation, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the 18th October 2022, apply to the High Court for this purpose.


