Admission arrangements will be dealt with in line with the LA's Admission Policy. No provision will be made for either selection by aptitude or pupil banding.

Transport of pupils shall be dealt with by reference to the LA's Home to School Transport Policy.

EXPLANATORY NOTE;

This note does not form part of the statutory notice, but is intended to explain its general purpose

- 1. Flintshire County Council acting as the Local Education Authority intends to increase the capacity of Drury Primary School, Drury from 1st September 2024.
- 2. This will mean providing an extension and remodelling the existing school to be ready from that date.
- 3. Arrangements will be made to provide continuity of provision at the school for pupils during the construction works.
- 4. The school will have an increased capacity from its current provision of 124 full time school places to 180 full time school places, an overall increase of 56 full time places from 1st September 2024. There will be 12 nursery places. This increase in capacity will accommodate the increasing demand for places at the school form within the area.
